3. Emergency criteria Article XIII (11) (e) requires the first Meeting of Parties (MoP1) to adopt criteria to define emergency situations that require urgent conservation measures and determine the modalities for assigning responsibility for action to be taken. The meeting is invited to discuss the development of these criteria. The interim Secretariat has prepared a paper which presents draft criteria for ACAP based on those prepared for AEWA. 4. Taxonomy Delegates to the 3 rd International Albatross and Petrel Conference, held in Montevideo, Uruguay, 23-27 August 2004, expressed their concern over confusion surrounding the taxonomy of albatrosses and petrels. Delegates emphasised that taxonomic consistency promotes coordinated conservation efforts and encouraged ACAP Parties to address this issue through the establishment of a transparent, scientific and consultative listing process. This issue is also referred to in Article IX (6) (b) of the Agreement. The meeting is invited to discuss the process by which an agreed taxonomy might be arrived at and provide advice to MoP1.
