## 2024 Call for ACAP Small Grant Applications

Applications are sought for project funding that will assist the Agreement on the Conservation of Albatrosses and Petrels (ACAP) meet its objective of achieving and maintaining a favourable conservation status for albatrosses and petrels. Total funding of approximately AUD \$200,000 is available for allocation.

Applications must be submitted on an ACAP Small Grants Application Form, available from <https://acap.aq/news/awards-grants-and-scholarships>. When assessing project applications, preference will be given to projects that address elements of the Advisory Committee Work Programme (see Annex 5, [AC14 Report](#)) and any research priorities identified by the AC Working Groups (see [AC14 Doc 12 Rev 1](#), [AC14 Doc 13 Rev 1](#) and [AC14 Doc 14 Rev 2](#)). Innovative proposals making a substantive contribution to the Agreement's objective will also be considered.

Applicants are encouraged to contact the relevant [Working Group Convenors](#) or the [Advisory Committee Chair](#) to discuss the development and relevance of their application to ensure it addresses the requirements of the AC Work Programme.

Applications open on 17 September 2024 and **close on Tuesday, 12 November 2024 AEDT (UTC+11h)**. Applications can only be submitted by ACAP Parties. Completed applications (in any of the three Agreement languages – English, French or Spanish) are to be forwarded to relevant [ACAP National Contact Points](#), who will then submit them to the [ACAP Secretariat](#) by the 12 November deadline.

Applicants will be advised of the outcome of their applications by 18 March 2025.
