

Avian Flu alert for fisheries crews onboard vessels

Stay updated on local and national avian flu guidelines and reporting of suspected cases

Be aware and safe

Always take a precautionary approach to accidental birds onboard!



Dead birds

Carcasses should be put overboard by crew wearing a mask, gloves, and goggles.

Where local regulations require fishers to keep bycaught carcasses, **seek guidance** on their proper storage.



Live birds

Trained crew, wearing gloves & a mask, should immediately **release the bird overboard**.



Wash hands with soap & water after handling dead or live birds.



Wash bird guano off boat surfaces with lots of seawater.

Any equipment in contact with the birds and their guano also needs to be disinfected

Bycatch mitigation measures **save seabirds** & help to **protect you from Avian Flu** (HPAI H5N1).
